The Magistrate has entered his decision pursuant to Civil Rule 53 and the Defendant, Donna M. Gauman, has thereafter filed objections to the decision.

The Defendant's Objections fail to comply with the express provision of Civ R 53 (E)(3) (c) which specifically state that "any objection to a finding of fact shall be supported by a transcript *of all the evidence* submitted to the Magistrate relevant to that fact or an affidavit of the evidence if a transcript is not available."¹ (Emphasis added.) Even though the Defendant requests the Court to review the evidence and decision of the Magistrate, no such transcript or affidavit is filed by her for the Court's review.

The Court after reviewing the Court's file, the Magistrate's decision, and having determined independently of the Magistrate's decision that there are no errors of law or other
